FCMTA PERFORMANCE MEDAL AWARD

This award is for students of FCMTA teachers, to encourage students to participate in FCMTA events as well as other performance opportunities, and also to encourage concert attendance.

Students earn points toward the "FCMTA Performance Medal Award" as follows:

- 20 points for performing in any FCMTA or FCMTA-sponsored event (Examples: Halloween Recitals, Ensemble Festival, Sonatina/Sonata Festival, Senior Living Center Performances, or the MSMTA Musicianship Testing or the MSMTA Theory Test given in Frederick County.) An additional 10 points are awarded to students who earn a "Superior" rating at an FCMTA-sponsored event.
- 20 points for performing in any event sponsored by an FCMTA teacher (Example: Studio recitals by FCMTA teachers.)
- 10 points for performing in a non-FCMTA event
 (Examples: MSMTA Composer's Circle, WVMTA event, church performance, retirement home performance, etc.) Performance must be done on student's primary instrument, or sung if student is a voice student. No more than 20 points total for this category.
- <u>5 points for ensemble performance</u>
 (Examples: Performing in a school band concert or singing in a church choir on Sunday, etc.)
 Performance does not have to be done with student's primary instrument. No more than 10 points total for this category.
- 10 points for attending a seated concert (instrumental or vocal recital)

 A Concert Attendance form must be filled out and submitted to the teacher to sign. The student's teacher must approve that the concert is of sufficient value to warrant awarding points for attendance. In general, eligible concerts include local community (e.g., school) concerts as well as those by professional organizations. Attendance must be in person.

To earn an FCMTA Performance Medal, students must acquire the following number of points in the following categories:

Performance Participation Points Required: 100 (Minimum of 60 points from FCMTA-sponsored events)

Concert Attendance Points Required: 30

Total Number of Points Required: 130

Program forms and information are available at www.fcmta.info. Teachers are responsible to gather all documentation and keep track of points. After all requirements have been met, the teacher sends the completed application and documentation of each event (including scores for judged events) to the Performance Medal chair:
